Greetings!

It is with great pleasure I bring to you information about the upcoming Presbyterian Youth Triennium 2010. Every three years, youth from around the country and world gather at Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana to share in this extraordinary conference. Participants are called to experience the gift of Christ's hope through small group meetings, recreation, a spirituality center, worship, singing, and personal interaction with youth and adults from all over the globe. Triennium is geared toward high school youth (those who will be rising 9th-graders through those who will have just graduated high school as of summer 2010) with special emphasis on spiritual formation and Christian discipleship.

Registration is now open for the National Capital Presbytery Delegation. We have 100 spaces on the bus and with over 100 churches in our Presbytery we expect to fill those spots easily. **Your space on the bus is reserved only once we have received your Non-Refundable deposit and personal registration information.** New this year, there is no limit on how many youth your congregation can send to Triennium, but if you plan to bring 10 or more youth, your church is responsible for providing an adult chaperone.

The full cost of the trip per person is \$630. I strongly urge your congregation to consider paying for part of the cost for each delegate as well as working with delegates to do fundraising in order to lower the cost paid by parents. Here is the schedule of payments:

- First deposit – due February 3rd: \$410
- Second deposit – due May 12th: \$220

Please do not let cost be a barrier! We have scholarship money available from the Presbytery, and I will be glad to work with you to figure out a solution to any issues.

Here are the first steps in the registration process:

1. Pray about your church's involvement at this year's conference. Pray for the youth who will be called to register for Triennium 2010.
2. Promote and advertise like crazy! Share promotional materials with your youth. Invite them to look at the website (www.presbyterianyouthtriennium.org) and print out information sheets for them to read.
3. Decide on your selection process. I trust you to make the best decision as to which youth from your church are most suited for this conference. These youth should be leaders and people who will thrive in an environment with 6,000 other youth. I have enclosed a sample application form if you would like to use that one, but feel free to make your selections through the process you see best for your congregation.
4. Select the youth who will represent your church and NCP at Triennium. For each youth, fill out the Youth Delegate form (enclosed) and return it to me at Providence Presbyterian Church with a \$410 Non-Refundable deposit. Please make checks payable to "National Capital Presbytery."

Registration deadline: February 3rd
